Pioneer shall not be held liable for damages that may happen if the GenerLink unit malfunctions and/or fails to function. The Member shall assume all liability for, and shall indemnify and hold harmless Pioneer, its employees, agents, contractors, subcontractors, and others acting in its behalf, against any and all losses, damages, costs, injuries, claims, expenses, attorney fees, and court costs incurred through the use and operation of this equipment, including, but not limited to, any and all claims for damages to property, equipment, and injury of persons resulting from, connected with, on account of, or arising out of (1) Pioneer's installation, (2) Member's operation and use of equipment, or (3) other acts or omissions of Pioneer.

No provision in any agreement, code, rules or regulations governing the relationship between Pioneer and Member are superseded by this Agreement.
