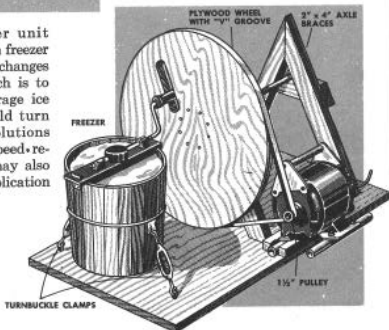

ICE CREAM FREEZER

This simple power unit to turn an ice cream freezer does not require any changes in the machine which is to be driven. The average ice cream freezer should turn at about 60 revolutions per minute. The speed-reducer on page 12 may also be used in this application of a portable motor.

PAY ONLINE: Use SmartHub at www.pioneerec.com. Pioneer will send you notification via email when your bill is posted online.

AUTO PAY: Authorize auto pay through SmartHub or by filling out a form. Your monthly bill will still be mailed to you, or you can select paperless billing and view it electronically.

PAY BY PHONE: Call 888.836.1422. The automated system allows you to enter your information securely. *Before you call you will need:* Your account number and the last four digits of the account holder's social security number or your chosen four-digit pin.

TRADITIONAL MAIL: Payment envelopes are included with your statement.

PAY STATION: Use Piqua office pay station 24-hours a day, seven days a week. The pay station accepts credit and debit card, check or exact cash. Payments will be posted to your account immediately.

PAY IN PERSON: Payments may be made in person at either the Piqua or Urbana office from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Both offices also have a 24-hour drive-up depository.
