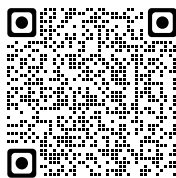
As a member-owned, democratically governed business Pioneer encourages member participation.

Board Trustees:

- Represent fellow members
- Employ the President/CEO
- Establish company policy
- Provide strategic direction
- Participate in electric cooperative training and conference opportunities

Each year three trustees, one from each district, are elected to a three-year term and can serve up to seven consecutive terms.

As a member of the board of trustees, you will be required to commit time beyond monthly meetings for training and education.

County Boards:

- Nominate trustees and district board members
- Act as a voice for members in your district
- Typically meet three evenings per year

Each year four trustees are newly elected to each county board for a three-year term and can serve up to seven consecutive terms.

Pioneer's current trustees and county board members all come from unique backgrounds and experiences.

Training and learning opportunities are provided to newly elected board members. Even if you have little or no experience in the electric industry, there is still an opportunity for you to serve on one of the boards.
