# BOARD OF TRUSTEES OR COUNTY BOARD – WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

## Board Trustees:

- Represent fellow members
- Employ the President/CEO
- Establish company policy
- Provide strategic direction
- Participate in co-op training and conferences

Each year three trustees, one from each district, are elected to a three-year term and can serve up to seven consecutive terms. As a member of the board of trustees, you will be required to commit time beyond monthly meetings for training and education.

## County Boards:

- Nominate trustees and district board members
- Act as a voice for members in your district
- Typically meet three evenings per year

Each year four trustees are newly elected to each county board for a three-year term and can serve up to seven consecutive terms.
